The systematic approach to effective conflict management Focused on some underlying principles of conflict management models such as:

1. Conflict is inevitable and that both positive and negative consequences may occur depending on how the conflict is managed.

- 2. The results are likely to be better with active engagement rather than avoidance.
- 3. People must be motivated to address conflict.
- 4. Behavioural, cognitive, and emotional skills can be acquired.
- 5. Emotional skills require self-awareness.
- 6. The environment must be neutral and feel safe

Further he also narrated his own life experiences in handling conflicts.

Students of Peri College of Arts and Science and other college students had actively listened and interacted with the speaker, and also came up with the brainstorming solutions to the problems posted by the expert.
