





The main motive of this survey camp is to collect data on availability of various infrastructure facilities like education, health monitoring, cultural activities and facilities for disabled person in the selected villages.</p> <p>After the survey the NSS volunteers came to know about the Latest development in agriculture, water facility, waste management, waste land development, nutrition and personal hygiene. This help the student volunteers to increase their analytical ability and deepen their thinking and also help them to categorize the problems which have been left unnoticed.</p> <p>Door to Door visit:</p> <p>NSS-PERIIT organized with the help of rural development Government of Tamil Nadu. The main aim of</p>

our program was to make these villages free from open defecation, to spread awareness about proper sanitation and waste management schemes. Around 40 student's volunteers were involved in this activity.

During the survey the NSS volunteers came to know the availability of basic toilet facilities in the houses of the villagers. This was very helpful to know the count of villagers who were involved in open defecation. By this survey the volunteers came to know about waste disposal and drainage facilities available for the villagers.

They gave them information about the diseases caused by open defecation. Villagers gave us a very good response. After that, we gathered all the villagers in one place and spoke about how to dispose the waste in a proper manner. The volunteers also came to know about their economic status and concluded that most of the villagers were poor to reconstruct their damaged toilets which were earlier allotted by the government, and few were still good.

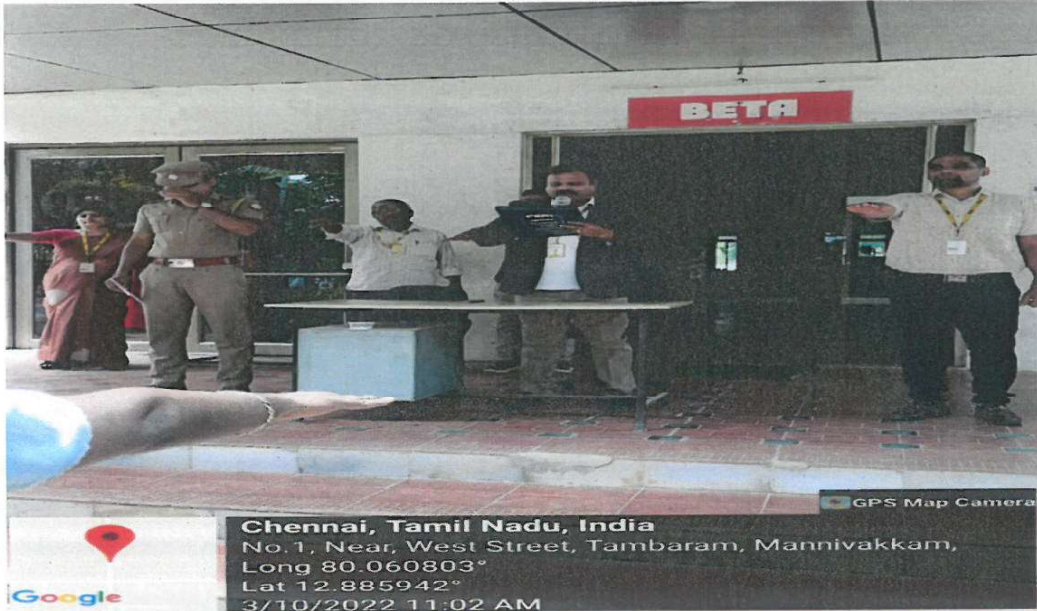

Report of the Activity	<p>In order to observe the drug abuse day YRC jointly with NSS organized an awareness programme on “Impact of Drug”. More than 500 take pledge again drugs. Our college drivers participated in it and remained benefitted from the programme. It's evident that addressing drug abuse among youth is a significant concern in India, with the alarming rate of daily suicides linked to drug abuse.</p> <p>The efforts highlighted, such as the National Youth Anti-Drug Media Campaign and National-level Anti-Drug Policies, reflect a proactive approach by the Indian government to combat this issue. Utilizing various media platforms like TV, radio, posters, pamphlets, and movie advertisements to disseminate prevention messages is a crucial strategy. The report indicating that exposure to such messages correlates with reduced drug abuse among youth underscores the effectiveness of these campaigns. The emphasis on engaging youth themselves in spreading anti-drug messages through events and campaigns is notable. Empowering young people to take an active role in promoting healthy lifestyles and preventing drug abuse aligns with the principal's view that youth are the nation's largest force and should be directed positively.</p> <p>Overall, while the challenge of combating drug abuse among youth remains significant, the concerted efforts outlined demonstrate a commitment to proactive prevention and intervention strategies.</p>

Prabhakaran, the YRC unit students of PERI Institute of Technology adopted Salavakkam village, Uthiramerur Taluk, Kancheepuram district, Tamilnadu, India for 7 days YRC camp program. The program was scheduled between 23.12.2019 to 29.12.2019 with 52 energetic YRC participants.</p> <p>DAY 1</p> <p>The camp started with the identification of problems in the adopted village from the President. YRC-PERIFT and Kalyani Speciality Clinic, Vadapalani organized the free general medical camp. Special treatment done by the doctors for the better health of the old age people. The major problem faced by them is improper open water bodies, improper garbage disposal in households, lack of plastic disposal awareness, and unrepaired roads. The students have done cleaning and repairing of halt place.</p>

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DAY 2

The camp focused mainly on general medical check-up and eye check-up which is known as basic need for the rural people. Similarly, a free eye check-up camp was done by Agarwal eye hospital, Tambaram. The attended people were satisfied with the service provided by us.

DAY 3

The main problems faced by the villagers were improper disposal of household and domestic wastages which are directly disposed to public premises and nearby open water sources. We planned a detailed schedule to remove the vast garbage which was irregularly dumped. The unrecyclable wastes are burnt and used in other ways as source

Prosopis juliflora tree which is know to absorb underground water and moisture from the air, are removed and used for various aspects.

DAY 4

Water scarcity has been the main problem in last decades, so we took steps to clean the open water bodies. Mainly concentrated on ponds and streams of water, we had put our hands together to remove the weeds over the water and maintain a healthy ecosystem. Mainly the over flow of garbage waste over the water are cleaned and disposed properly. Over the village we observed the water and done the work to safe guard and clean them.

DAY 5

Wide varieties of plant and tree saplings are distributed and planted over the surroundings. Due to lack of afforestation and usage of fire wood decreased the count of trees over there. The saplings of neem and other herbal are freely distributed among the villagers and few are planted near the slopes of the village to avoid soil erosion. Villagers grounded the saplings and started the work to maintain its growth

DAY 6

Due to lack of awareness of govt. schemes and job opportunities many people are unemployed and lack of health awareness. We had organized a rally to create awareness and make people understand the need and importance of various aspects. Locality people also supported us by spending their valuable time to listen regarding the rally. Various awareness programmes like hazardous impact of dengue and its breeding, govt. schemes like DDU GKY, PMKY etc., were conducted.

DAY 7

Plastics are been a challenge to us in disposal and recycling. Due to poor facilities of disposal they dumped them on the roads and few buried them in grounds. We took a step to segregate this type of waste and spread awareness not to burn them in open space. The camp could manage to overcome the problems at the village.


