


Fig1: Speaker - DR. B. Ezhilavan




Fig 7: Perspective of AI

Trainer had also given the coding's for creating the chess game where the students are asked asked to combine the coding's for the game and the movement of the chess pieces in the direction to which they can win the game.






Fig 13: Students working on given task day 2








Fig 14: Students working on game codings




Fig 17: Hand-On to students




Fig 22: Project presentation by Mr. Harish Anand and its team (student)




Fig 23: Project coding presentation by Mr. Abdul and its team (student)
